

INTRODUCTION


Churchfields Academy is set on a beautiful site with views of Christ Church in the Old Town of Swindon and Liddington Hill. Churchfields Academy is a learning community of approximately 800 students between the ages of 11 and 16 year. The Academy's main reception is in Salcombe Grove: however there is also a second entrance in the same road and a third in nearby Falmouth Grove.

BY BICYCLE



There is secure cycle storage available for students. Students must dismount before entering the Academy gates and should then lock their cycles securely in the storage available. Students leave their cycles at their own risk and the Academy accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage whilst on site.

National Cycle Network Route 45 runs alongside Queens Drive, close to Churchfields, and there are good links to other parts of the town.

BY BUS

Churchfields Academy is located close to the town centre, with convenient bus links from all areas of Swindon. The nearest bus stops to the Academy are on Upham Road, for Thamesdown Transport's Service 17.

A variety of ticket options are available, which you can buy on the bus (no change given), and smartcards are also available for Thamesdown Transport services from the office on Fleming Way. If you travel by bus regularly, save money by getting a TravelPass which gives you unlimited travel on Thamesdown and Stagecoach buses.
