INTRODUCTION

ON FOOT

The school entrance is a couple of minutes' walk from Akers Way. Pedestrian crossings are right next to the school driveway, to enable our students to cross safely. See the map for walking routes to the site.


BY BICYCLE

We have plenty of cycle storage facilities at the school. Students who cycle are directed to the left hand side of the school entrance, to avoid the pedestrian barriers at the bottom of the driveway. Students are encouraged to be wary of vehicles and use the pedestrian crossings clearly visible. Students are advised to bring their own lock and key to ensure that their bicycle can be locked securely during the day. The storage area is not accessible to students during the school day.

BY BUS

There are public bus stops near Nova Hreod Academy on Akers Way. Thamesdown Service 12 runs between St Andrew's Ridge and the Great Western Hospital, via Swindon town centre and Service 15 runs between Haydon Wick and Wichelstowe, also via the town centre.

For details of buses, times and routes see www.swindonbus.info or call Traveline on 0871 200 22 33. A variety of ticket options are available, which you can buy on the bus (no change is given, so you will need to ensure you have the correct fare), and Smartcards are also available for Thamesdown Transport services from the office on Fleming Way. If you travel by bus regularly, save money by getting a Travel Pass which gives you unlimited travel on Thamesdown and Stagecoach buses and is valid for 4 weeks.

Real time bus information: To find out when the next bus is due, text the bus stop code (found on the bus stop flag or the map) to 84268.

BY CAR


