



BY CAR



Vehicle access to the College during the day is controlled by a gate with a buzzer link to Reception. There is limited visitor parking on site. Blue badge holders can park in designated disabled spaces near the front entrance. Parents may enter the site before 8.15am to drop off students but are encouraged to use car parks at the nearby Tesco store or the County Ground for drop-off and collection whenever possible. Ocotal Way is a designated clearway and cars are not permitted to stop outside the College site.
